Sainte-Foy-Bordeaux
 Patrick de Coninck's vineyard lies on very fine
 slopes just south of the River Dordogne, west
 of Ste. Foy La Grande. This wine, "Réserve
 de la Famille" is made from the best parcels of
 the vineyard and has been vinified and
 matured with the same attention to detail as
 the greatest wines of Bordeaux and it is
 stylistically similar. It was aged for 18 months in
 new oak barriques. Following the example set
 by Francois Mitjavile, Patrick de Coninck, with
 regular advice from Francois' son Louis, has

created a new level of excellence within a hitherto undistinguished appellation. Again, the attention to extreme detail here is apparent and the results are equally impressive. I doubt if a Medoc first growth receives any better treatment than that lavished on the best vines and barrels in the new chai at Martet. This is the solution for those who consider classed growths too expensive. Wine containing 100% Merlot manually picked on south-west oriented Graves soil. Malo-lactic fermentation in 100% new barrels. A nice smell of prunes and truffles. In the mouth, balanced, well-structured, full-flavoured. Dominating fruit. Superb creamy richness, roundness and charm are the key words.

Vieux Château Landon 1996

Haut-Médoc, Cru Bourgeois
The vineyards of Vieux Château Landon are situated in center of Médoc area on the Begadan district. The origins of Vieux Château Landon go far back in history, attested by the archives dating back to 1607, carefully preserved to this days. They show that the property belonged to numerous generations of wines growers, being handed down from father to son. This has given it its standing and its quality. On arrival at the winery, the grapes are de-stemmed and gently crushed. The grapes then arrive in the vats for the alcoholic fermentation. During this first fermentation, regular remontages or pump-overs are effectuated in order to extract a maximum colour, aromas and tannins. The temperature is controlled about 30 to 32°C. After a period of about 15 to 18 days maceration, the wine is drained and the skins gently pressed. The second malo-lactic fermentation takes place in afterwards in separate vats. Following the end of the malo-lactic fermentations, the wines are raked in order to remove the heavier lees. Around mid January the wines are transferred to our barrels, of which 1/3 are renewed annually. After 18 months in barrel the wines are fined with egg white and bottled at the Château.
